

<b>Whaea Kiri</b>	Ata mārie. <i>Good morning.</i>
<b>Tamariki</b>	Ata mārie, Whaea. <i>Good morning, Miss.</i>
<b>Whaea Kiri</b>	Jo, kei hea tō pukapuka? <i>Jo, where is your book?</i>
<b>Jo</b>	Kei runga i taku tēpu. <i>It's on my desk (table).</i>
<b>Whaea Kiri</b>	Homai. <i>Give it to me.</i>
<b>Whaea Kiri</b>	Hana, homai tō pukapuka. <i>Hana, give me your book.</i>
<b>Hana</b>	Anei, Whaea. <i>Here it is, Miss.</i>
<b>Whaea Kiri</b>	Hana, he aha tēnā? <i>Hana, what's that (near Hana)?</i>
<b>Hana</b>	Aua, Whaea. <i>I don't know.</i>
<b>Jo</b>	Hana, nā Haami, nē? <i>Hana, It's Haami's eh?</i>
<b>Hana</b>	Homai, Jo. Homai! <i>Give it to me, Jo. Give it!</i>
