Curriculum Guidelines for Teaching and Learning Te Reo Māori in years 1 to 13 in English-medium settings Te Aho Arataki Marau mō te Ako i te Reo Māori – Kura Auraki

2009 sees the launch of the *Curriculum Guidelines for Teaching and Learning Te Reo Māori in English-medium settings.* These guidelines have been developed for primary and secondary schools where te reo Māori is taught as a second language. They have been designed to support teachers with a range of language teaching expertise and proficiency in te reo Māori.

The curriculum guidelines will be launched in early 2009 and 20 one-day workshops will be held nationally during March and early April 2009 to assist schools to use these guidelines. There is no charge to attend but schools will need to cover any associated teacher release costs.

Schools are invited to send at least three representatives to your local workshop; preferably the teacher in charge of te reo Māori, a member of senior management and a whanau representative. Support staff members, the resource teachers of Māori and/or board of trustees members are also invited.
