

- Hana** Kia ora anō. Ko Dylan tō hoa, nē?
Hi again. Dylan's your mate, eh?
- Haami** Āe. Ko Hana koe, nē?
Yes. You're Hana, eh?
- Hana** Āe.
Yes.
- Haami** Nō whea tō whānau, Hana?
Where's your family from, Hana?
- Hana** Nō Rotorua. Nō hea tō whānau?
From Rotorua. Where's your family from?
- Haami** Nō Porirua.
From Porirua.
- Hana** Ko wai tō kaiako, Haami?
Who is your teacher, Haami?
- Haami** Ko Whaea Arihia.
Miss Arihia.
- Jo** Hana, kia tere! Haere mai!
Hana, hurry up! Come here!
- Hana** Taihoa, Jo! Ka kite anō.
Hang on, Jo! See you around.
- Haami** Āe, ka kite anō.
Yes, see you again.

Jo	E kī, Hana! <i>Well, Hana!</i>
Hana	He aha? <i>What?</i>
Jo	Nō hea a Hāami? <i>Where's Haami from?</i>
Hana	Nō Porirua. <i>From Porirua.</i>
Jo	He pai a Haami ki a koe? <i>Do you like Haami?</i>
Hana	Kāo! <i>No!</i>
Jo	Āe! He pai a Haami ki a koe. <i>Yes! You like Haami.</i>
Hana	Āe, pea. <i>Yes, perhaps.</i>
Jo	He ātaahua a Haami, nē? <i>He's good looking, eh?</i>
Hana	Āe. <i>Yes.</i>
Kaiako	Koutou mā, whakarongo mai! <i>Everyone, pay attention!</i>

- Jo** Hana, titiro! Kei konei a Haami.
Hana, look! Haami is here.
- Hana** Kei hea?
Where?
- Jo** Arā, kei muri.
Over there, behind (you).
- Hana** Auē! Anei, Haami.
Oh no! Here, Haami.
- Haami** Āroha mai. Kia ora, Hana. Kei te pēwhea koe?
Sorry. Thanks Hana. How are you?
- Hana** Kei te pai. Kei te pēhea koe?
Good. How are you?
- Haami** Kei te pai. He pai te poitūkohu ki a koe?
Fine. Do you like basketball?
- Hana** Āe. He pai te poitūkohu. Anei tō pōro.
Yes. I like basketball. Here's your ball.
- Haami** Kia ora, Hana.
Cheers, Hana.
- Haami** Kua wera au.
I'm hot.
- Hana and Jo** Āe! Kua wera ia!
Yes! He's hot!
